



Kiwanis Club of St. Augustine Scholarship Application

Scholarship Awards for 2017

The Kiwanis Club of St. Augustine will award four \$500 scholarships to students attending St. Augustine High School, St. Joseph's Academy, Pedro Menendez High School, Florida School for The Deaf & Blind and St Augustine Technical High School. Each recipient will be allocated \$500.

The scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors entering college in the fall of 2017. The conditions of the award are that the recipients must enroll as full-time, degree seeking student at regionally accredited colleges or universities in the United States.

Selection Criteria

Scholarships are based on academic achievement, citizenship, and leadership without regard to financial need. Candidates must rank in the upper 30 percent of their class, and must score above the 50th percentile on either the ACT or SAT. In addition, candidates must be exemplary school citizens and should be regarded as leaders in their schools. Participation in extracurricular activities is an important consideration in the selection process.

Application Procedures

1. Get the the Scholarship Application from your guidance counselor, advisor or Kiwanis Club.
2. Request sealed copy of your transcripts to be mailed with your application. The transcript must include your current class rank and your test scores from either the ACT or SAT.
3. Request three letters of recommendation: one from each of the following person: your guidance counselor or principal; a teacher; and a person, other than a family member, outside your school. Letters should give information regarding students citizenship, leadership, community service, and/or extracurricular activities.
